Positive institutional accreditation of The Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts Schools of Architecture, Design and Conservation

On 9 June 2020, the Accreditation Council granted The Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts Schools of Architecture, Design and Conservation a **positive institutional accreditation**, cf. section 8 of the Accreditation Act¹.

A positive institutional accreditation means that the institution can make adjustments to existing study programmes and local provisions of study programmes, cf. section 9(1) of the Accreditation Act. The institution can also establish new study programmes and new local provision of study programmes when they have been pre-qualified and approved, cf. sections 18 and 21 of the Accreditation Act.

The accreditation is valid until and including 9 June 2026, cf. section 9 of the Accreditation Act.
