Positive institutional accreditation of University of Southern Denmark

On 2 March 2021, the Accreditation Council granted University of Southern Denmark a **positive institutional accreditation**, cf. section 8 of the Accreditation Act¹.

A positive institutional accreditation means that the institution can make adjustments to existing study programmes and local provisions of study programmes, cf. section 9(1) of the Accreditation Act. The institution can also establish new study programmes and new local provision of study programmes when they have been pre-qualified and approved, cf. sections 18 and 21 of the Accreditation Act.

The accreditation is valid until and including 2 March 2027, cf. section 9 of the Accreditation Act.
