## Conditional positive institutional accreditation of the Royal Academy of Music

On 17 March 2022, the Accreditation Council granted the Royal Academy of Music **a conditional positive institutional accreditation**, cf. section 26 (1) of the Accreditation Act<sup>1</sup>.

A conditional positive institutional accreditation means that all new study programmes and local provisions of study programmes will have to be accredited before they are established cf. section 10(1) of the Accreditation Act. The institution can make adjustments to existing study programmes and local provisions of study programmes.

The accreditation is valid until and including 17 March 2028, cf. section 10(1) of the Accreditation Act.
