Positive institutional accreditation of IT University of Copenhagen

On 27 September 2022, the Accreditation Council granted IT University of Copenhagen **a positive institutional accreditation**, cf. section 8 of the Accreditation Act¹.

A positive institutional accreditation means that the institution can make adjustments to existing study programmes and local provisions of study programmes, cf. section 9(1) of the Accreditation Act. The institution can also establish new study programmes and new local provision of study programmes when they have been pre-qualified and approved, cf. sections 9, 18 and 21 of the Accreditation Act.

The accreditation is valid until and including 27 September 2028, cf. section 9 of the Accreditation Act.
