## Positive institutional accreditation of Roskilde University

On 24 November 2022, the Accreditation Council granted Roskilde University **a positive institutional accreditation**, cf. section 8 of the Accreditation Act<sup>1</sup>.

A positive institutional accreditation means that the institution can make adjustments to existing study programmes and local provisions of study programmes, cf. section 9(1) of the Accreditation Act. The institution can also establish new study programmes and new local provision of study programmes when they have been pre-qualified and approved, cf. sections 18 and 21 of the Accreditation Act.

The accreditation is valid until and including 24 November 2028, cf. section 9 of the Accreditation Act.
