Positive institutional accreditation of Aarhus University

On 24 September 2024, the Accreditation Council granted Aarhus University a **positive institutional accreditation**, cf. section 8 of the Accreditation Act¹.

The Accreditation Council finds, that the institution's quality assurance work, with the exception of few and minor problems, is well-considered, systematic and well-functioning in practice.

A positive institutional accreditation means that the institution can make adjustments to existing study programmes and local provisions of study programmes, cf. section 9(1) of the Accreditation Act. The institution can also establish new study programmes and new local provision of study programmes when they have been pre-qualified and approved, cf. sections 9, 18 and 21 of the Accreditation Act.

The accreditation is valid until and including 24 September 2030, cf. section 9 of the Accreditation Act.
