My report has been prepared in relation to the periodic institutional assessment of the Ecological University of Bucharest (hereinafter, UEB). This is the result of my participation as the international expert of the ARACIS Panel that visited this academic center on site on 10-12 May 2023. The Panel carried out its activities according to the programme approved by Marius Gabriel PETRESCU, PhD (in his capacity as the ARACIS Evaluation Mission Director) as well as by Giuliano TEVI, PhD (who is the UEB's Rector) (see Annex 1).

The ARACIS Expert Panel was made up by twelve persons, namely: Marius Gabriel PETRESCU, PhD (full professor, Petroleum-Gas University of Ploiesti); Dumitru MIRON, PhD (full professor, Bucharest University of Economic Studies); Florentina MUNTEANU, PhD (full professor, "Aurel Vlaicu" University of Arad); Petrica Claudiu POP SITAR, PhD (full professor, Technical University of Cluj-Napoca); Virgil ENE-VOICULESCU, PhD (full professor, "Mircea cel Batran" Naval Academy of Constanta); Vasilica NEGRUT, PhD (full professor, "Dunarea de Jos" University of Galati); Levente DIMEN, PhD (full professor, "1 Decembrie 1918" University of Alba Iulia); Rodica ENACHE, PhD (full professor, "Ovidius" University of Constanta); Ana Maria LUPU (student of "Gheorghe Asachi" Technical University of Iasi); Radu Ionut STAN (student of "George Emil Palade" University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science, and Technology of Targu Mures); Alexandru MANOLACHE (ARACIS technical secretary); and myself (Gabriela Alexandra OANTA OANTA, associate professor of public international law and international relations at the University of A Coruña (Spain) and Holder of the Jean Monnet Chair "European Union law of the sea" co-financed by the European Union).

As required by Article 2(2) of the civil agreement signed with the ARACIS for this evaluation activity, I had to use my own knowledge, skills and experience in order to prepare this Report. Moreover, I used the qualitative and quantitative data available in the documents provided by the ARACIS and UEB, both before and during the evaluation visit.

Before the evaluation visit, I have reviewed the UEB's self-assessment report in view of the periodic institutional assessment and its annexes, which were prepared by this University and

provided to me by the ARACIS. I also reviewed the documents, data and information available on the UEB's website. In this regard, I paid special attention to the documents on the institutional organization of this University (available at: www.ueb.ro) and its mission (see: https://www.ueb.ro/en/manag_calitate/), the admission to its different academic programmes (see: https://www.ueb.ro/en/ueb_admitere.php) as well as the information on the Erasmus+ Programme (see: <https://www.ueb.ro/erasmus/>) and research activity (available at: <https://www.ueb.ro/en/#>).

As scheduled in the programme of the evaluation visit, on 10-12 May 2023 I participated to the meetings with: the UEB's representatives; the academic staff corresponding to curricula that were subject to the evaluation; employers' representatives; the members of the Ethics Commission; teaching staff at undergraduate and master degree levels; students; and graduates of different studies at Bachelor and master degrees. Moreover, I had additional meetings with Ciprian Alexandru-Caragea, PhD, Vice-chancellor and Coordinator of Scientific Research and International Relations, as well as with Ms. Iulia Dumitru in her capacity as the Coordinator Institutional Erasmus+. The evaluation visit ended with the meeting of the Panel members with various representatives of this University. The visit on site during these three days represented an excellent opportunity to enhance information I had received on the UEB and its activities before this visit. In this regard, mention should be made to the documents I asked for and received during the visit on site, some of them having been attached to this Report.

The UEB is a private university, which is part of the Romanian higher education system. It is well-known as the first private university that has been established in April 1990. Throughout its existence, the UEB has been accredited by virtue of the Law 282/2003 and has received the qualification "Trusted" that has been awarded by the ARACIS Executive Bureau following the evaluation carried out in this respect. The same qualification has been received by its undergraduate degree programmes and master's programmes in the last years. At present, the UEB is composed of seven Faculties, namely: the Faculty of Ecology and Environmental Protection, the Faculty of Law, the Faculty of Financial Management, the Faculty of Physical Education and Sport, the Faculty of Communication Sciences, the Faculty of Management Engineering, and the Faculty of Psychology.

During its existence of thirty-three years, the UEB has been able to consolidate itself in the Romanian academic landscape. The word "ecologic" in the official name of the University has helped it to individualize itself in the Romanian university system – this has been very well reflected moreover in the official name of several faculties and undergraduate and master's degrees – and has been outstandingly reflected in the organization of many prestigious international academic events.

With regard to the latter, I would like to mention the organization by the UEB of, among others: the International Conference "Ecology of XXI Century – Only One Earth" (Bucharest, 4-8 April

2022), the International Conference "Ecology of XXI Century – The European Climate Pact" (Bucharest, 29 March-2 April 2021); the International Conference "Ecology of XXI Century" (Bucharest, 1-4 April 2019); the International Conference "Ecology of XXI Century" (Bucharest, 2-4 April 2018); etc. A special mention should be made to the Scientific conference "Ensuring the right to a healthy environment and the challenges of the transition to EU" (Bucharest, 12 May 2023), which has been organized with Sweden's support and the participation of numerous foreign researchers; or to the international conference on "Urban planning law and climate change: challenges and perspectives" that will be organized as a hybrid event on 20-21 September 2024. From my experience as an international evaluator for ARACIS, I can say that to date there is a huge distinction between public universities, on the one hand, and private universities, on the other hand, in Romania. This distinction is made by the Romanian public authorities as, at this moment, private universities are not eligible for state budget funds based on the number of students and research carried out by their teaching staff, while public universities are eligible for such funds. I believe therefore that private universities are at a clear disadvantage in this field. Despite this, however, the UEB has been able to transmit its academic offer to potential students and the outstanding level of many members of its teaching staff, at least in the field of "Law" that, as a Romanian law graduate, I can best appreciate.

During the meetings carried out with the UEB's graduates of different studies at bachelor's and master's degrees and also with the employers' representatives – which have taken place on 10 May 2023 – I have had the opportunity to see the close teacher-student relationship and the excellent impression of the employers' representatives on the very good preparation of the graduates of this University. It seems to me that a student, who expresses his/her intention to ask for an advice or for clarification on the subjects studied, can get an answer from the teaching staff-member in charge with the course.

I would also like to point out that the UEB has a modern infrastructure, adequate equipment and the logistics necessary for learning/teaching and research that ensures the development of the educational process. It has to be mentioned that all of these elements are the result of the exclusive contribution of the University and of the fees paid by its students. It is expected that the project "Tranzitie digitala si eco-climatica!" [translation: "Digital and eco-climatic transition!"] financed through the National Recovery and Resilience Plan will help the UEB to develop its necessary digital infrastructure from which fourteen laboratories (eight laboratories that already exist and six new laboratories) and four research centers (two that already exist and other two new centers) would benefit. For more details on this project, which has been financed with more than 16 millions lei, see: <https://www.ueb.ro/tdec/obiective/> Additionally, the UEB has institutional partnerships with, for instance, Romania's Ministry of

Environment, Water and Forests, which has helped it to enhance its attractiveness to potential students.

Against this background, I can argue that the UEB benefitted so far from outstanding human elements: on the one hand, the commitment of the teaching staff and authorities of this University, and, on the other hand, its graduates' training, which enabled many of them to find a good place in the labour market.

However, I have identified three weaknesses. I will now make a serie of comments and recommendations in relation to each of them. It is my hope that they could help the UEB to consolidate the position from which it already benefits in the Romanian academic landscape and also to Europeanize itself. It should not be forgotten that the UEB is settled in Bucharest, which is the capital of an European Union's Member State that is situated in a corner of Europe.

My first comment is in relation to the teaching staff's research activity. As mentioned above, it is considered that there is sufficient qualified staff to ensure the conduct of teaching activity at undergraduate and master levels. Nevertheless, it is noted that research could be improved. It is well known that quality university teaching requires both research and practical experience.

Under my view, there is a significant difference between, on the one hand, a very few professors of very high academic level, and, on the other hand, the large part of the teaching staff. In this regard, it should be underlined the large number of appointments as *Doctor Honoris Causa Professors* in the case of four members of the UEB's teaching staff – in total 16 appointments -, which have been made by universities from Romania and Moldova (see Annex 2).

Furthermore, although the UEB does not have its own IOSUD, it is worth noting that ten professors of its teaching staff are PhD supervisors in different research institutes belonging to the Romanian Academy, or at the "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" Police Academy of Bucharest, the University of Pitesti, the University of Bucharest, and the University of Bucharest (see Annex 3). Additionally, different members of the teaching staff of the faculties that compose the UEB are members of the editorial boards of various scientific journals that have been indexed by ISI (Clarivate), EBSCO, ProQuest, Heinonline, EconLit, etc. (see Annex 4) and also have actively participated to international conferences and are members of international professional associations. I consider, however, that, with only a few exceptions, there is a problem of generational change in the UEB's teaching staff.

In this sense, I recommend that the number of publications should be increased and the internationalization of research activity should be encouraged. In my opinion, the

internationalization of research activity cannot consist basically of participating in international conferences organized by the UEB itself. In other words, I believe that the UEB's teaching staff should: *firstly*, participate in conferences organized by foreign universities; *secondly*, publish articles in journals indexed in international databases; *thirdly*, publish monographs, codes, books and book chapters in prestigious foreign publishers; and, *fourthly*, establish synergies of collaboration with professors and research groups from foreign universities. Additionally, the UEB should create a research fund for its teaching staff dedicated to financing research stays abroad.

According to the Annex 2(6) of the Self-assessment report in view of the periodic institutional assessment, since the 2014/2015 academic year the minimum weekly teaching norm is increased to 16 conventional hours per week. While the Annex 3(7) of the same Report in relation to the internal assessment on the scientific research for 2022 indicates that the research activity represents 25% of the total number of hours in the teaching staff's timetable. teaching staff. Against this background, I consider that a research fund for financing the UEB's teaching staff's research activity should be created. This could contribute: *firstly*, to improve the teaching staff's research and teaching activity; *secondly*, to internationalize the teaching staff's research activity; *thirdly*, to improve the CV of the younger Faculty members in order to get a higher academic position; and *fourthly*, to access external funds for research.

My second comment is in relation to the research projects. During my visit on site, many members of the UEB's academic community have referred in numerous occasions to the importance of the funds of the project "Tranzitie digitala si eco-climatica!" [translation: "Digital and eco-climatic transition!"] financed through the National Recovery and Resilience Plan. But these funds will be dedicated to improving the digital infrastructure of this University. Unfortunately, no reference has been made to the preparation of applications for international research projects. Therefore, I highly recommend the UEB considering the possibility of applying for international calls for projects where no distinction – and no discrimination – is made between public and private universities. In this way, the UEB could make use of the human capital of the teaching staff it already has and its attractiveness as being a university settled in Romania's capital.

My third comment refers to the UEB's internationalization activity. I consider this aspect should be developed and improved.

Currently, the UEB counts on the "Erasmus Office" (in Romanian, "Biroul Erasmus"), which is in charge with managing the mobilities under this well-known programme of the European Union. In my opinion, the institutional strengthening of the UEB in this area is more than necessary. It could be made through the creation of an Office of International Relations. Such a body can usually be found at public and private Universities in Romania. It should be staffed by academic and administrative personnel: to support the UEB in its internationalization

process and the UEB's teaching staff and students in their international approach; to prepare and apply for projects of external funds to be managed by the UEB itself; to try to have access

to other European funds, which do not represent only mobilities under the Erasmus+ Programme and that do not depend on the national authorities in charge with the management of the European Union's funds. Maybe the administrative personnel, who already works for different UEB's administrative units, can received a specific preparation in order to start working in such an Office.

Additionally, I would like to recommend the UEB to increase the number of the Erasmus+ mobility agreements as well as to reactivate the already existing Erasmus+ mobilities. Such mobilities for the teaching staff could contribute to the internationalization of the UEB's research activity and also to improve this university attractiveness for potential students.

Finally, the participation of the UEB in the EU Careers Amabassadors Programme (https://epso.europa.eu/en/eu-careers/eu_careers_student_ambassadors#tab-How%20to%20apply) could contribute to its better visibility at national level and also internationally. It would also represent an interesting opportunity for the UEB's students to have access to an international projection. During the current academic year only three universities from Romania take part in this programme and only four Romanian universities will participate to it during the 2023/2024 academic year.

I consider that all these actions will allow the UEB to defend its position on the Romanian university scene and, at the same time, to meet its need for Europeanisation.
