External Institutional Evaluation Report

### "Hyperion" University of Bucharest November 2023

I have prepared this report on the institutional evaluation of the "Hyperion" University of Bucharest (hereinafter, UHB) in my condition as the international expert of the ARACIS Panel that visited this academic center on-site on 22-24 November 2023. The Panel carried out its activities according to the programme approved by Dorian COJOCARU, PhD (in his capacity as the ARACIS Mission Director) and Sever SPANULESCU, PhD (who is the UHB's Rector) (see Annex 1). The ARACIS Expert Panel was made up by fourteen persons, of which eight persons were involved in the UHB's institutional evaluation, and the other six persons focused on the assessment of specific programmes of studies.

Thus, the Panel in charge with the institutional evaluation was made up by: Dorian COJOCARU, PhD (full professor, University of Craiova); Ioan Calin ROSCA, PhD (full professor, "Transilvania" University of Brasov); Florentina MUNTEANU, PhD (full professor, "Aurel Vlaicu" University of Arad); Vasilica STAN, PhD (full professor, University of Agronomic Sciences and Veterinary Medicine of Bucharest); Alexandru MANOLACHE (ARACIS technical secretary); Sergiu COVACI (students' representative and ANOSR's delegate. Technical University of Cluj-Napoca); Madalin-Gabriel FLOREA (students' representative and UNSR's delegate, "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iasi); and myself, Gabriela Alexandra OANTA OANTA, PhD (associate professor of public international law and international relations at the University of A Coruña (Spain) and Holder of the Jean Monnet Chair "European Union law of the sea" co-financed by the European Union).

Additionally, the ARACIS evaluators in charge with the assessment of specific programmes of studies were: for Physics - Learning on-site, Luminita Moraru, PhD (full professor, "Lower Danube" University of Galati); for Geography - Learning on-site, Sandu BOENGIU, PhD (full professor, University of Craiova); for Economy of Trade, Tourism and Services - Distance learning, Mircea NEAGOE, PhD (full professor, "Transilvania" University of Brasov) and Iuliana CIOCHINA, PhD (full professor, "Constantin Brancoveanu" University of Pitesti): for Science Politics - Learning on-site, Gabriela RATULEA, PhD (full professor, "Transilvania" University of Brasov); and for Clinical Psychology and Psychological Counselling - Learning on-site, Rodica Gabriela ENACHE (full professor, "Ovidius" University of Constanta).

Under the Article 2(2) of the civil agreement signed with the ARACIS for the UHB's institutional evaluation, I had to use my own knowledge, skills and experience in order to prepare this report. I moreover used the qualitative and quantitative data available in the documents provided by the ARACIS and UHB, both before and during the evaluation on-site visit.

Before the evaluation visit, I reviewed the UHB's self-evaluation report on academic quality assurance at institutional level (hereinafter, the UHB's self-evaluation report) and its annexes, which were prepared by this University and provided to me by the ARACIS. I also reviewed the documents, data, and information available on this University website both in Romanian (https://www.hyperion.ro/) and in English (https://www.hyperion.ro/en/). In this regard, I paid special attention to the documents on the institutional structure and organization of this University (available at: https://www.hyperion.ro/structura-si-organizare/carta-si-planurilestrategic-si-operational) as well as on its regulations and methodologies (see: https://www.hyperion.ro/structura-si-organizare/regulamente-si-metodologii), the admission and Faculties to the different academic programmes (see: https://www.hyperion.ro/admitere), as well as the information on the Erasmus+ Programme (available at: https://erasmus.hyperion.ro/).

As scheduled in the programme of the evaluation visit, on 22-24 November 2023 I participated to the meetings with the UHB's representatives, the academic staff corresponding to curricula that were subject to the evaluation, employers' representatives, the members of the Ethics Commission, teaching staff of different Faculties, students, and graduates of different studies at bachelor and master degrees. Moreover, I had different meetings with Andrei Mihai Cristea, PhD, UHB's Academic Secretary, that were especially useful in order to gather additional information and clarifications in relation to the dossier prepared for the evaluation mission. I should also mention that the meeting with Mr. Marius Ghibertic, who is currently the UHB's General Erasmus+ Coordinator, was very useful. He helped me to understand how the Erasmus Office's activity was organized and the steps this University did recently in order to internationalize some aspects of its academic activities. The evaluation visit ended with the meeting of the Panel members with various representatives of this University.

The on-site visit during these three days represented an excellent opportunity to enhance information I had received on the UHB and its activities before this visit. In this regard, mention should be made to the documents I asked for and received during the visit, which I have attached to this report. In relation this, mention should be made to the documents I have attached to this report as annexes 2-4 have. They have not been signed yet by the UHB's representative, but I consider them useful in order to support my assessment.

I would like to thank Professors Dorian Cojocaru, Ioan Calin Rosca and Vasilica Stan for the way they handled this evaluation mission as well as all the other members of the Panel for their fruitful talks held over those days. A special thanks goes to Mr. Alexandru Manolache for his support from the very beginning, when I was invited to join this Panel. I would also like to thank to the UHB's Rector, Professor Sever Spanulescu and his team for their hospitality, their availability for answering to all my questions and for providing me the requested information.

The UHB is a private university, which has been recognized as a university of the Romanian higher education system since 1995 according to the Article 103(2) of the Law 84/1995 of Education (republished) (see annex A.1.1 of the UHB's self-evaluation report). However, it had been founded five years before as part of the Hyperion University Foundation, of which it separated in November 1992 under the Civil Decision 315 of 19 November 1992 of the Court of District 1 Bucharest (see annex A.1.2 of the UHB's self-evaluation report).

Throughout its existence, the UHB has received the accreditation or has been provisionally authorized to function, depending on the case (see annex A.1.11 of the UHB's self-evaluation report), at bachelor's or master's levels. Thus, seventeen bachelor programmes organized by seven faculties – the Faculty of Exact and Engineering Sciences; the Faculty of Social, Humanistic and Natural Sciences; the Faculty of Legal Sciences; the Faculty of Journalism; the Faculty of Psychology; the Faculty of Economic Sciences; and the Faculty of Arts – and fourteen master programmes organized by these faculties have been or are currently in this situation.

Some of these academic programmes have been organized as learning on-site at the UHB's venue (which counts on two buildings) and others under the form of distance learning. Five of the 37 programmes were submitted to this external evaluation visit (see the visit programme of the ARACIS Panel as the annex 1 of this report). As for the external evaluation of the UHB's academic quality, the last evaluation took place in 2015, its results were included in the report of the ARACIS Council that was approved on 24 September 2015, and awarded UHB the rating "Trusted" (see: <a href="https://www.aracis.ro/wp-content/uploads/2019/08/Raport Consiliu 398cf9.pdf">https://www.aracis.ro/wp-content/uploads/2019/08/Raport Consiliu 398cf9.pdf</a>).

As it is very well-known, private universities that are part of the Romanian University System – as it is the case of the UHB, too – may not benefit from the state budget funds, which are distributed by the Ministry of Education based on the number of students and research carried out by their teaching staff. At the UHB, the costs of students' training have been largely covered by tuition fees paid by the students themselves (see annex A.2.18 of the UHB's self-evaluation report). I consider that, over the years, this has caused a significant difference among the universities (being public or private) that have been authorized to conduct academic activities in Romania. Despite this situation, the UHB has known how to attract

students and outstanding members in the teaching staff and, therefore, to consolidate its position on the Romanian university scene. I would also like to point out that, despite these characteristics of its budget, the UHB has a policy of awarding tuition grants and facilitating the payment of tuition fees, in accordance with articles 18 and 19 of the Regulation on granting scholarships and other forms of material support and facilities for students at the Hyperion University of Bucharest (see annex A.2.20 of the UHB's self-evaluation report).

One of the most positive aspects that I was able to see during the meetings held on 22 and 23 November 2023 concerns the important relationship that has been often built between the students and the teaching staff, and which continues even after the end of the studies. This special relationship has even been transmitted to a significant part of those who hire UHB's graduates (of both bachelor's and master's degrees). This allows me to affirm that, during its existence of more than three decades, the UHB has benefited from the human element, being it constituted by its representatives, the students, the members of teaching staff, and the business companies that host UHB's students on internships or which hires graduates or master's degree holders.

Below, I would like to point out a series of aspects that I consider that the UHB should work on in order to improve its situation on the Romanian university landscape. In this regard, I will make a series of <u>comments</u> and <u>recommendations</u> that I believe could benefit the UHB in its future activity. They refer to the teaching staff's research activity, the research projects, and the internationalization activity.

Firstly, as for the <u>teaching staff's research activity</u> is concerned, I would like to highlight the great efforts made by an important part of the faculties members to raise funds for the conduct of their research and the publication of their scientific results. Much of this funding has been obtained through participation in the research teams led by other universities or through contracts signed individually with public and private entities (see annex 2 of this report).

At the same time, I would like to recommend the UHB to create a special fund for research to which members of its teaching staff could apply. This would increase the UHB's research quality and its links with its personnel. This fund would help the UHB's teaching staff to participate in conferences organized by Romanian and international universities, to publish articles in journals indexed in international databases as well as monographs, codes, books and book chapters in prestigious Romanian and foreign publishing houses, and also to create and develop synergies of collaboration with professors and researchers from other universities.

The creation of such fund would be in line with the normative on research activities that has already been adopted by this University, such as: the UHB's Charter (see annex A.1.24 of the UHB's self-evaluation report) and its Strategic and Operational Plans (see annexes A.1.45

and A.1.46 of the UHB's self-evaluation report), the Strategy of Scientific Research for the period 2020-2024 (see annex B.3.1 of the UHB's self-evaluation report) and the Plans of Scientific Research that have been adopted for each of its seven faculties (see annex B.3.2 of the UHB's self-evaluation report) as well as the Operational procedure on the quality of elaboration of the strategy and scientific research plans (see annex B.3.7 of the UHB's self-evaluation report).

Secondly, regarding the <u>research projects</u>, I would like to recommend the UHB to support its teaching staff to present proposals for national and international calls. In this regard, at the Romanian level, there are different calls managed by the Romanian Executive Agency for Higher Education, Research, Development and Innovation Funding (UEFISCDI; <a href="https://uefiscdi.gov.ro/">https://uefiscdi.gov.ro/</a>) to which members of the UHB's teaching staff could also apply. I consider it could be of special interest for the UHB to apply for the call on collaboration projects with Republic of Moldova. Under this call, a consortium can be created by, for example, the UHB and at least one of the public and/or private university from the Republic of Moldova. This type of collaboration could allow the UHB to attract funds for academic research, would increase its collaboration with other research teams and would be made it known to potential foreign students.

There are moreover international calls for proposals to which the UHB's teaching staff could submit project proposals. I am referring, among others, to the calls managed by the European Education and Culture Executive Agency (<a href="www.eacea.ec.europa.eu/index\_en">www.eacea.ec.europa.eu/index\_en</a>) and other calls for proposals and tenders that are available on the European Union's platform of Funding & tender opportunities (<a href="webgate.acceptance.ec.europa.eu/sedia/portal/screen/home">webgate.acceptance.ec.europa.eu/sedia/portal/screen/home</a>).

This kind of initiatives could benefit from the inexistence of distinction or discrimination between public and private universities. In this way, the UHB could make use of the human capital of its teaching staff it already has and its attractiveness as being a university settled in Romania's capital would be increased. In addition to the positive aspects that this funding could bring, as I mentioned earlier when I referred to the positive aspects of the creation of a special fund for research, it could increase the number of databases that could be consulted by both teachers and students (the current databases are mentioned in annex 3 of this report). These new funds could undoubtedly contribute to the richness of education under the umbrella of the UHB.

Thirdly, in relation to the <u>internationalization activity</u>, I would like to underline that, based on the documentation provided to me before the on-site visit and also on the meetings I personally had on 22 and 23 November 2023, I can state that this aspect needs to be improved.

At present, there is an Office for international academic mobilities that counts on a head at

the UHB level and a representative for each specialization (the information is available on the UHB's website – see: <a href="https://erasmus.hyperion.ro/erasmus/erasmus-officers/">https://erasmus.hyperion.ro/erasmus/erasmus-officers/</a>; I think this information need to be updated). The head of this Office, Mr. Ghibertic, is currently working on the reactivation of this activity.

In relation to the UHB's international activity, I would like to mention that at the beginning of its existence, various collaboration agreements were signed with prestigious foreign institutions (see annex A.1.48 of the UHB's self-evaluation report). However, they were not renewed, and it seems that, during years, there was not a concern to sign new partnership agreements either.

My impression is that now there is a desire to reverse this situation. During the on-site visit, information on four recent inter-institutional agreements under the Erasmus+ Programme has been provided to me (see annex 4 of this report). Thus, in February 2019 such an agreement was signed between the UHB and Siedice University of Natural Sciences and Humanities (Poland), by virtue of which students of different areas (such as Languages, Economics, Political sciences and civics, Informatics, and History and archaeology) could do an Erasmus mobility. Another inter-institutional agreement was signed between the UHB and University of Valencia (Spain) in 2021, which allowed students of Journalism and reporting to benefit from. The UHB's students of Journalism could also benefited from an Erasmus mobility according to the inter-institutional agreement signed with the Faculty of Media from Ljubljana (Slovenia) for the 2021-2022 academic year. However, these three agreements have not be renewed and are not therefore into force at present. The only Erasmus agreement (Key Action 1) that is active for learners and staff at present is the one signed by the UHB with Alanya Alaaddin Keykub at University (Turkey) for the period 2020-2024.

Under this context, I highly recommend the UHB to renew the old Erasmus agreements, to sign new Erasmus agreements and to increase therefore the number of such agreements. These agreements should refer either to the students or the teaching staff. Such mobilities could contribute to the UHB's internationalization and to the improvement of its attractiveness for (Romanian and foreign) potential students.

The UHB's internationalization activity could benefited a lot from other European Union's programmes, too. I recommend the UHB's participation to the EU Careers Student Amabassadors Programme (the information in English may be accessed at: <a href="https://eu-careers.europa.eu/en/eu-careers/eu careers student ambassadors">https://eu-careers.europa.eu/en/eu-careers/eu careers student ambassadors</a>; the information in Romanian is available at: <a href="https://eu-careers.europa.eu/ro/eu-careers/eu careers student ambassadors">https://eu-careers.europa.eu/ro/eu-careers/eu careers student ambassadors</a>). I consider that this programme, on the one hand, will give a better visibility of the UHB at national level and also internationally. And, on the other hand, it will represent a very strong attraction for the UHB's students. The Romanian participating universities for the academic year 2023-2024 are as follows: National University of Political Studies and Public Administration (SNSPA), Public Administration Faculty; "Stefan">https://eu-careers.europa.eu/ro/eu-careers/eu careers student ambassadors</a>). I consider that this programme, on the one

cel Mare" University in Suceava, Faculty of Law and Administrative Sciences; University of Bucharest, Faculty of Business and Administration; and Romanian-American University, School of Management-Marketing.

It is my believe that these actions will allow the UHB to defend its position into the Romanian university system as well as to meet its need for Europeanisation.
