This Final Report was prepared on the basis of Article (20) (2)(f) (i) of the Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education and the establishment and operation of an Agency on related matters laws of 2015 to (No 2) of 2020 [N. 136 (I)/2015 to 138(I)/2020].

THE PROCEDURE:

On the 16th of December 2021, the legal representative of the Higher Education Institution European University of Cyprus submitted an application (Doc. 200.1), based on Article (17) of the Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education and the Establishment and Operation of an Agency on Related Matters Laws of 2015 to (No 2) of 2020, for the evaluation-accreditation of the program of study:

IN GREEK: Πληροφοριακά Συστήματα (4 ακαδημαϊκά έτη, 240 ECTS), Πτυχίο (BSc)

IN ENGLISH: Computer Information Systems (4 academic years, 240 ECTS), Bachelor (BSc)

This application is registered in the file with the reference number: 07.14.327.086

In the framework of competences conferred on it by the relevant legislation, the Council of the Agency has constituted an External Evaluation Committee (EEC) which, after initially examining the institution's application for program evaluation and accreditation, performed a remote visit at the institution on 31st March 2021.

The EEC **remotely** met with the head of the institution, the head of the relevant department, the program's coordinator, members of the academic staff, and members of the administrative staff, students and / or their representatives and the Internal Quality Assurance Committee.

Additionally, the EEC **remotely** examined the institution's facilities (library, computer labs, research infrastructures, etc.), various documents presented and/or requested by the EEC, the School's/ Faculty's structure and the program's position in it, the CVs of the teaching staff and their relationship to the institution as teachers in regard to any other duties and teaching in other programs of study.

The EEC has documented its findings and recommendations and drew up the External Evaluation Report in the Doc. 300.1.1.

CYQAA Council's Decision

The Council of the Cyprus Agency of Quality Assurance and Accreditation of Higher Education, during its 68th Summit on 14 and 15 of June 2021, on the basis of Article 20 (2)(f)(i) of the Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education and the Establishment and Operation of an Agency on Related Matters Laws of 2015 to (No 2) of 2020 [N. 136 (I)/2015 to 138(I)/2020], and on the basis of the suggestions of the External Evaluation Committee, the comments of the institution on the report **decided that the program is accredited to be delivered in English.**

According to the recommendations of the EEC and the decision of the Agency, **the Institution is required, within six months and no later than 30th December 2021, to provide evidence and data confirming compliance with the following:**

- Provide incentives and support to faculty members that will enable them to increase their level of engagement in research and publications. To this end, the institution should also revise the existing workload of faculty members.
- Enhance transparency of the program through publicizing all information pertaining to the ESG Information Management
- Reconsider the learning outcomes in all courses to provide students the essential knowledge, skills and attitudes necessary for pursuing studies at a graduate level.

The current accreditation begins in the **Fall** semester of the academic year **2021 – 2022** and ceases to be in effect at the end of the **Spring** semester of the academic year **2025 – 2026.**

On the basis of Article (4) of the relevant Legislation, it is noted that "the above accreditation is valid for the period provided by the provisions of the Law and is repeated every five (5) years and that the procedure starts at the request of the institution which must, and shall be submitted at least sixteen (16) months before the expiry of the previous accreditation".

Additionally, on the basis of Article (17) (3) (f) during the period of validity of the Accreditation, the Agency acting of its own motion, may examine whether the criteria continue to be met and if they are not met, then the Agency shall revoke the Accreditation, and immediately inform the institution concerned.
