- The Register Committee considered the Substantive Change Report of 29 February 2016. The Committee sought and received clarification from evalag on a number of issues.
- 2. The Register Committee took note of the changes to evalag's criteria for Quality Management Audit (in Austria), International Programme Accreditation, International Institutional Accreditation and Evaluations of Fields of Study, which were revised in light of the adoption of the Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the European Higher Education Area (ESG, 2015).
- 3. The Register Committee took note of the information provided on evalag's newly offered Certification of Advanced Study Programmes. Based on the information provided, the Committee concluded that this new activity complies with the key requirements of the ESG, as far as this can be established within the limitations of the substantive change process.
- 4. The Register Committee considered the information and further clarification on the newly offered Certification of Advanced Educational Institutions. Based on evalag's clarification, the institutions targeted by this offer are part of the higher education system. The activity is thus within the scope of the ESG.



- 5. ESG standard 2.3 stipulates that "external quality assurance processes should be [...] pre-defined [...] and published", while standard 2.5 stipulates that any "outcomes or judgements [...] should be based on explicit and published criteria".
- 6. The Committee concluded that evalag's practice to provide the corresponding guidelines, setting out the process and criteria applied, to institutions on request only, while not making them publicly available on its website, is a violation of standards 2.3 and 2.5.
- 7. The Register Committee therefore requests evalag to either publish the process and criteria as required by the ESG, or to discontinue the activity.
- 8. The Register Committee expects evalag to make a further report until 7 July 2016 at the latest, including appropriate evidence that the standards have been complied with. Failing to do so, the Register Committee will consider to initiate an extraordinary revision of evalag's registration per §8.1 ff of the EQAR Procedures for Application.

Description new/changed *

Since 2015 evalag offers certification of (advanced) training programmes within the scope of two different processes: institutional certification of (advanced) educational institutions as well as programme certification of advanced training offers. Both activites were developed according to the ESG and to the procedures of programme and system accreditation in Germany.

Institutional certification validates and confirms that the institution has established effective processes and instruments for the quality assurance of their offers. Certification criteria are: goals and profile of the institution, governance and steering, resources, teaching and learning as well as quality assurance.

Programme certification validates the congruence between qualification goals and the conceptualisation as well as the effectiveness of its implementation. Its objective is to confirm that the intended qualification goals and the desired competence profile can be achieved, and it determines the level on which these competences are to be classified on the scale according to the DQR (German Qualifiacations Framework). The following criteria are considered: profile of the programme, organisation of the advanced training offers, resources, curriculum, examination system and quality management. The criteria are defined and published (ESG 2.5).

Both certification processes are generally carried out as peer-review-process including a self-assessment or equivalent, a site-visit, a report and and a consistent follow up (ESG 2.3). Both involve all relevant stakeholders. The review team is composed and trained in accordance to accreditation procedures and includes a student member (ESG 2.4).

Certification will be granted for five years, recertification for seven years. The final decision on the award of the certificate rests with the Accreditation Commission of evalag. Reports are published (ESG 2.6). The appeals commission is responsible for dealing with complaints and appeals (ESG 2.7).

The certification is aligned with the ESG (see linked PDF, ESG 1.1-1.10) and the quality standards of the German society for scientific training (DGWF). Besides, institutional certification is guided by the recommendations for quality development within the university advanced education of Swissuni (in the version dated October 2009).

The new procedures are embedded in the thematic analyses and the internal quality assurance of the agency (ESG 3.4 und 3.5).

Please note also that evalag adjusted all its criteria for full compliance with the modified ESG. The evalag foundation board adopted the criteria on February 18th 2016.
