Description new/changed	ACSUCYL carries out evaluations of International Master Programs prior to their submission to the European Commission Call for Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters. For these evaluations, ACSUCYL follows the guidelines of the "European Approach for Quality Assurance of Joint Programmes", developed to ease external quality assurance of these programmes, and the "Evaluation Protocol for International Joint University Degrees in accordance with the European Approach for Quality Assurance of Joint Programmes", set by the Spanish Network of University Quality Agencies (REACU).
	At the request of the Universities of the University System of Castilla y León, ACSUCYL has carried out two evaluations of Joint Masters,

following the guidelines specified in the
European Approach, approved by EHEA
ministers in May 2015. Thus, the criteria and
procedure have been followed, with all the
requirements when constituting the evaluation
panels, development of the visit, etc. In the
development of these processes, the materials of
the IMPEA project (Facilitating implementation of
the European Approach for Quality Assurance of
Joint Programmes) have been useful.
The final variety of these processes are
The final reports of these processes are
approved by the Degree Evaluation Commission,
framed within the degree evaluation processes.
As an example, the Final Evaluation Report
