A. Has the organisational identity of the registered agency changed?	No

Description	In full compliance with its 2019 statutes (Art. 6, 1.b and 1.c), the MusiQuE Board signed an agreement with the European Association of Music in Schools (EAS) in January 2021 recognising EAS as a partner organisation. Since then, EAS is "empowered to make nominations for appointment of board members" and the MusiQuE Board counts a new member.
	For further reference, Art. 6, 1b. and 1c. of MusiQuE's statutes stipulate as follows: •1.b. The members of the Board shall be appointed by the Board on the nomination of the Foundation's partner organisations. •1.c. The Board shall at all times be empowered to recognise organisations as partner organisations time. These partner organisations shall then be empowered to make nominations for appointment of board members of the foundation.

This change did not require any alternation of the statutes, nor it implied subsequent amendments of the members' nomination procedure.

As indicated in MusiQuE's External Review Report of July 2020, this new partnership solely reflects MusiQuE's drive to enhance its stakeholders' model in ways that better reflect and represent the area of music education in general. Further, it brought to MusiQuE a better reflection of its inclusive competence towards a crucial sector for the teaching of music, from a cultural and social point of view – the school being the potential place of access to music for the great majority of future professionals.
