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1. The Register Committee considered the Substantive Change Report of 2026-03-09.
2. The Register Committee took note of PKA President appointing a Vice-president of the organisation, and the PKA Presidium establishing the composition and activities of the PKA Quality Council. The Committee further learned that tasks and activities of this Council primarily relate to internal quality assurance of PKA's activities.
3. Based on the detailed information provided in the Substantive Change Report, the Register Committee had no concerns that the ESG are complied with in the case of PKA establishing its Quality Council. However, in line with its registration decision for PKA of [2024-04-16](#), the Register Committee reiterates that the functioning of Quality Council and other PKA bodies (i.e. the Presidium, the Vice-President) should be analysed in-depth in the next external review of PKA, specifically with regards to ESG 3.1, ESG 3.3 and ESG 3.6.

Description	<p>1. The President of PKA, Professor Janusz Uriasz, appointed Professor Jacek Tarasiuk as Vice-President of PKA (18 September 2025).</p> <p>2. In December 2025, the Presidium of the Polish Accreditation Committee (PKA) appointed the Quality Council of PKA's activity, an advisory body supporting the internal quality assurance of the agency's operations. The Council was established pursuant to §11a of the PKA Statute, in accordance with the applicable statutory procedure.</p> <p>The concept and scope of the Council's activities were the subject of internal reflection and consultations within the agency over the recent period. The adopted solution was gradually developed and tested in practice in the context of enhancing the consistency and transparency of PKA's evaluation procedures and further strengthening the agency's internal quality</p>

assurance arrangements.

The Council is composed of the Secretary of PKA and reviewers of evaluation reports representing different academic fields, including current and former members of the Committee as well as PKA experts. The Council also includes a representative of the student community and a representative of the socio-economic environment (employers).

The Council supports PKA in particular by analysing the quality and consistency of review reports prepared by evaluation panels, identifying good practices and formulating recommendations aimed at the further enhancement of evaluation procedures and related documentation. Through these activities, the Council contributes to the continuous development of PKA's internal quality assurance framework.

Further details on the establishment, composition and responsibilities of the Council are provided in the attached document.
