### **Positive institutional accreditation of Business Academy Aarhus**

On 30 September 2021, the Accreditation Council granted Business Academy Aarhus a positive institutional accreditation, cf. section 8 of the Accreditation Act<sup>1</sup>.

A positive institutional accreditation means that the institution can make adjustments to existing study programmes and local provisions of study programmes, cf. section 9(1) of the Accreditation Act. The institution can also establish new study programmes and new local provision of study programmes when they have been pre-qualified and approved, cf. sections 18 and 21 of the Accreditation Act.

The accreditation is valid until and including 30 September 2027, cf. section 9 of the Accreditation Act.
