The Non-Profit Organisation “Eurasian Centre for Accreditation and Quality Assurance in Higher Education and Health Care” (ECAQA) hereby informs you of the decision of the Accreditation Council dated 30 June 2025, Minutes No. 5, to accredit the educational programmes in the specialties 60910200 – “General Medicine” (Uzbek, Russian and English mediums of instruction) and 60910100 – “Dentistry” of the International Medical University “Central Asian Medical University” (CAMU) for a period of five (5) years, from 30 June 2025 to 29 June 2030.

Post-accreditation monitoring, in accordance with the accreditation process, will be carried out by ECAQA over the five-year period, with the submission of an annual report on the implementation of the recommendations provided by the External Expert Commission for the improvement of the educational programmes.

An informational letter regarding the international accreditation of the above-mentioned educational programmes will be sent to the Ministry of Health and the Ministry of Higher Education, Science, and Innovation of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

As an accreditation agency recognised by the World Federation for Medical Education (WFME) until 2032, ECAQA will submit information on the accreditation status of the bachelor's degree programme in the specialty “General Medicine” (Uzbek, Russian and English mediums of instruction) of CAMU for publication on the WFME Portal of accredited basic medical education programmes.

The next step will be to inform and ensure the inclusion of the accreditation status of the “General Medicine” programme of CAMU in the World Directory of Medical Schools, maintained by the WFME and the Foundation for Advancement of International Medical Education and Research (FAIMER).

The accreditation status of the bachelor's degree programmes in the specialty “General Medicine” (Uzbek, Russian and English mediums of instruction), granted by a WFME-recognised accrediting agency, enables compliance with the requirements of the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG). It allows both domestic and international graduates of medical educational institutions in the Republic of Uzbekistan to be eligible to take the USMLE (Step 1 and Step 2) examinations in the United States in order to apply for postgraduate clinical residency training programmes.


The external evaluation reports and the decision of the Accreditation Council will be published in the European Database of External Quality Assurance Results (DEQAR) and the Asia-Pacific Database of Quality Assurance Results (DAQAR). As a full member of the European Association for Quality Assurance in Higher Education (ENQA), ECAQA officially publishes the full version of the External Expert Commission report in accordance with the requirements and implementation of the key parameters of the Bologna Process.

The full versions of the External Expert Commission reports, the decision of the ECAQA Accreditation Council, and the Accreditation Certificates of the CAMU educational programmes will be published on the ECAQA website in the “Reestr” section: <https://www.ecaqa.org/en/reestr-en>.
